










Land Use Scenario & Visioning Planning Charrettes TPO staff conducted 12 community charrettes to obtain input for the development of transit supportive Land Use Scenario Plan for each of the six SMART Plan corridors.





Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Studies Workshops

Miami-Dade Transit and FDOT are inprogress with the environmental phase of each of the six SMART Plan corridors. This includes an evaluation of transit options – mode, alignment, and station stop locations.



TPO staff participated in over 65 outreach activities to increase awareness of the SMART Plan and obtain public input.























Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP)

Projects constructed in 2017 from TAP awards included:

- Miami-Dade DTPW: Old Cutler Trail Reconstruction from SW136th Street to Cartagena Plaza
- Doral: Bike lanes along NW 52nd Street from NW 107th Avenue to NW 97th Avenue and along NW 102nd Avenue from NW 41st Street to NW 58th Street
- City of Miami springs: Westward Paved Path along Westward Drive from Flamingo Circle to Hammond Drive
